# Town of Cohutta Occupational Tax Instruction Sheet

The Town of Cohutta passed an Occupational Tax Ordinance on the 7<sup>th</sup> of December 2021 to impose regulatory fees on businesses subject to jurisdiction of Cohutta, Georgia.

All businesses located within the Cohutta Town limits must obtain an Occupational Tax Certificate.

#### **Important Items**

A Georgia Sales Tax Number is required prior to the issuance of an Occupational Tax Certificate (if applicable). If you need assistance, please contact the Department of Revenue at 1-877-423-6711 or one of their regional offices found at the following website <a href="https://gtc.dor.ga.gov">https://gtc.dor.ga.gov</a>

A North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) code is also required. NAICS codes are numbers that indicate your primary line of business. NAICS is a self-assigned system. No one assigns you a NAICS code. Visit <a href="https://www.naics.com">https://www.naics.com</a> to find your corresponding code.

All applicants will abide by applicable federal/state/local laws.

Initial on the application form that you will become compliant with E-Verify and SAVE.

Check the appropriate boxes on the application form if you have over or under 11 employees and your exemption status.
